Here at ESB-USA quality is one of our top priorities and constant efforts, we truly stand behind our products with pride and confidence. If you ever have a problem or question concerning quality please contact us, we will do whatever we can to resolve the issue with you. Our product promise: we guarantee that every thawed IUI vial contains at least 10 Million motile cells in a 0.5 ml volume, and that every ICI vial contains at least 15 Million motile cells in a 1.0 ml volume.

Clients will sometimes ask why we, and many other sperm banks, offer 10 million motile cells per IUI vial. The answer is simple and backed with science. Researchers found that if the number of sperm used to attain pregnancy was increased a plateau was reached at 10 million motile cells, the addition of more cells did not increase the success of achieving pregnancy (Van Voorhis et al.). In an independent study, researchers found no increase in the rate of achieving pregnancy when between 200 thousand and 200 million motile cells were used in intrauterine insemination (Cressman et al.). ICI vials often have more motile cells per vial since clinics will often wash the sample themselves. The extra motile cells provide a margin for clinics since a portion of the cells are lost during processing.

From Profiles to Pregnancy: Your Guide to Purchasing Vials

1. Find and Purchase Information on Your Favorite Donors

Use our detail-specific search functions to browse donors and narrow your list. Once you've decided on your favorites, more in-depth information is available. You can purchase materials individually or for \$50, our 3-month All-Access Pass will unlock the complete portfolio for every donor. This includes their 4 generation family medical history, downloadable audio interviews, baby photos and personality assessments. You'll even receive staff impressions written by our knowledgeable Client Services Team.

2. Fill Out Related Paperwork

Prior to receiving any vials from ESB-USA, we ask that you fill out any forms related to your purchase.

Our Recipient Semen and Storage Agreement outlines the terms you and ESB-USA agree to in purchasing, storing and/or using donor semen. Every client is asked to complete this form and return it to us before vials are received.

The Clinic Release form provides prior written authorization from the licensed health care professional you are working with. This document applies to purchases from clients who request to have vials delivered to any location in New York State or a location that is not a clinic (i.e. for an at-home insemination). For New

York State clients, this form can only be signed by a physician, physician's assistant, or nurse practitioner. For at-home inseminations, it can be completed by a physician or other licensed health care personnel. Both forms may be submitted via fax or email.

3. Place Your Order for Donor Sperm

Once you have decided on a donor, you should order the specimens as early as possible. You may order donor sperm directly on our website or over the phone through one of our trained staff members. You can pay by credit card including Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. Please know the vial type and quantity you wish to order upon the time of purchase.

4. Shipping or Storing Vials

Upon placing your order, you can also note where and when you want your vial(s) to arrive. We ship to any worldwide destination, so call us for details.

In addition, we offer storage options for a long term plan. If you wish to make sure that sperm from your favorite donor is available for later use, you can reserve vials ahead of time and store them at our facility until needed. A storage account ranges from a minimum of 1 month to 5 years.

If you wish to set up a storage account, please email us at info@europeanspermbankUSA.com or call 1.800.709.1223. Vials must be prepaid before storage can begin. Storage can be canceled at any time and 75% of the vial cost will be refunded. Storage rates are not prorated. Only vials that are still stored and haven't left our facility are considered eligible for the Buy-Back Program.



Vial Exchange & Buy Back Program

All clients are encouraged to purchase enough vials for their needs up front for multiple attempts and/or additional pregnancies. A donor can sell out at any time, so being prepared in advance ensures access to your chosen donor when you are ready.

Occasionally, a client changes their mind about the donor they purchased and have units of sperm placed in storage. This can happen as new donor options become available with desired characteristics or the stored donor's overall vial supply runs low.

Whatever the reason, we are proud to offer the Vial Exchange & Buy-Back Program to ensure that you have available to you the best donor possible. There is no cost to you for exchanging comparable vials, as ESB-USA wants to make sure you are 100% confident in your donor selection. Buy back vials are purchased by ESB-USA for 75% of the original purchase price.





In order to be eligible for the vial exchange or buy back program, all vials must have been purchased and stored at ESB-USA without ever leaving the premises. Samples that have left our facility are no longer eligible for the exchange or buy back feature.

Vials will only be exchanged for equal or lesser value vials to those currently being stored. Should a request be made for more expensive vials than those in storage, the client will be responsible for the difference.

Vial exchange or buy back is subject to approval by ESB-USA. Any refunds will be made via check sent within three weeks of vial cancellation. Terms and conditions are subject to change.


Insemination Methods – Explained

Donor Sperm Definitions, Preparation Methods and Vial Types

ESB-USA offers different vial types for different applications and fertilization techniques.

Semen that has been prepared for **Intrauterine Insemination** is known as an **IUI** specimen. These vials are sold in a **.5ml volume** and, when properly stored and thawed, are guaranteed to contain at least **10 million motile cells**. They are also referred to as "washed" samples because the processing they are put through separates the live sperm from the seminal fluid. That fluid is then replaced with a cryopreservant before the sample is frozen. This type of specimen is required for IUI procedures because the dead sperm, white blood cells and prostaglandins found in unwashed semen not only interfere with the fertilization process, they can cause cramping and pain when inserted directly into the uterus.

Semen that has been prepared for **Intracervical Insemination** is known as an **ICI** specimen. These



vials are sold in a **1.0ml volume** and, when properly stored and thawed, are guaranteed to contain at least 15 million motile cells. These vials can also be referred to as "unwashed" because they are not processed. These samples retain all of the naturally occurring seminal fluid and cells. There will be plenty of motile sperm but dead sperm are also still present. The cervix and cervical fluid will only allow the highly motile sperm cells to make it into the uterus and fallopian tubes, just as it happens through intercourse. Due to the nature of raw semen, these samples are suitable for intracervical and at home inseminations only, unless they are washed by your fertility specialist.

As a cost saving alternative, ESB-USA offers what are known as **ART** samples. Available in both IUI and ICI preparations, these vials are priced at a significant discount because they contain fewer total motile cells than our guaranteed premium vials. IUI ART vials contain 4-9 million motile sperm in a .5ml volume and ICI ART vials contain 5-14 million motile

sperm in a 1.0ml volume. These numbers are more than sufficient for use in **Assisted Reproductive Technology** procedures such as IVF, ICSI, GIFT & ZIFT. In other circumstances, ART vials can be used successfully on their own or combined in multiples for standard insemination techniques. Please call to find out our current availability.

Consult Your Physician

You should consult with a healthcare professional about which insemination method is most appropriate for your circumstances. Your medical provider can provide guidance on the type and quantity of vials recommended for the procedure you will be undergoing.


Demystifying Methods of Insemination Clinic Inseminations

The procedures used for intrauterine insemination (IUI) and intracervical insemination (ICI) are somewhat similar. Inseminations must be precisely

timed based on a woman's natural cycle or in conjunction with fertility medications intended to induce ovulation. The woman is normally positioned on an examination table as if in preparation for a pelvic exam. A speculum is placed in the vagina so the cervix is visible. A sperm sample is then inserted through the cervical opening using an insemination catheter attached to a syringe. For an ICI procedure, the sample is injected into the cervix. For an IUI procedure, the sample is injected directly into the uterus. Of the two procedures, IUI is commonly believed to have a slightly better success rate than ICI.

Home Insemination

Artificial insemination can be done at home and performed on oneself or by their partner with either vial type. Home inseminations involve the use of either a syringe or a cervical cap to place the sperm as close to the cervix as possible at the correct time in the woman's cycle. For women who are free of fertility issues, home insemination can save on cost due to the absence of medical office fees, although a licensed practitioner must agree to sign the required release





paperwork. Despite pregnancy rates not being as high with this method, many women choose to make this a starting point in their fertility journey and do find success.

IVF

In vitro fertilization is a process by which fertilization is performed outside of the body. IVF may involve any combination of your own eggs and sperm or those from a donor. After egg and sperm cells have been harvested from the patient or obtained from a donor source, they are brought together in a laboratory environment under optimal conditions to allow the sperm to fertilize the eggs. About 2 to 5 days after fertilization, one or more of the best embryos

are inserted into the uterus with a catheter. The remaining embryos may be cryopreserved for future use. For any ART/IVF procedures, ART-ICI samples can be purchased from ESB-USA but, as with our premium ICI vials, they must first be "washed" by your fertility professional. Due to the extensive preparation and delicate nature of an IVF cycle, fertility clinics will frequently require you to provide two samples; one for immediate use and an extra one for backup.

What is CMV?

What is CMV?

Cytomegalovirus, or CMV, is a common virus known to infect people from all populations and ages. In developed countries, 50 to 85% of adults have been infected by age 40. In developing countries, nearly 100% of the population has been exposed. CMV is a member of the herpes virus family which includes cold sores, chicken pox and infectious mononucleosis. Unfortunately, there is no vaccine for CMV.

In healthy adults and children, symptoms of an active CMV infection are usually mild and could be mistaken for a cold or the flu. The affected person should fully recover in a week or two with no lasting effects. Some people may experience an active infection and not even notice any negative symptoms. During an active infection, the virus is shed in body fluids. This means it can be contracted through exposure to urine, saliva, blood, tears, breast milk and semen.

Once a person becomes infected and passes the initial illness, the virus lies dormant in their body for the rest of their life, with little risk of recurrent infection or reactivation. Couples in which one partner contracts the virus will typically pass it on to the other through kissing and intimate contact, which results in both partners sharing the same CMV status and mutual, natural immunity. However, it is impossible to be certain of your CMV status without obtaining a blood test.

Why is this important regarding pregnancy?

If a woman has never encountered CMV and has her first exposure during pregnancy, there is a 30 to 40% chance of her fetus being infected as well. The majority of children born who experienced a CMV infection before birth are healthy and normal, however, 10 to 15% may have complications such as hearing loss, neurological abnormalities or decreased motor skills. Infants who are infected with CMV after they are born rarely experience any long-term complications.

How does this affect my donor sperm choice?

To reduce the risk of adverse pregnancy outcomes, any woman planning to use donor sperm to conceive should have her CMV status tested. If the donor sperm recipient has never been exposed to CMV, her status should be negative. This means she does not have the antibodies and resistance to the virus. In order to reduce the risk of infection to her unborn child, she may want to select a sperm donor whose CMV status is also negative. If the recipient's test results come back positive, meaning she has experienced prior exposure and subsequent immunity, she can select a sperm donor who is either positive or negative.

What type of CMV testing do sperm donors go through?

Donors are given an initial CMV screening to determine their CMV status. Donors are tested for IgG and IgM antibodies. If a donor is IgG positive and IgM negative, the donor has had a past exposure to CMV but does not have an active infection. If a donor is IgG negative and IgM negative, then he has not had a CMV infection. If a donor is IgG positive and IgM positive, then he has an active infection. All donors with an active infection are barred from donating until the donor tests IgM negative. Any potentially affected vials are discarded. Donors are tested every 3-6 months for their CMV status.

Specializing in Open Identity Donors

As children conceived using sperm from anonymous donors grow into adulthood, many lament the fact that policies of anonymity cut them off from half of their genetic inheritance. They may hunger to know more about their donor's story, from family traits to life histories, even whether he was musically inclined or not. Such a sense of belonging is taken for granted by most of us, but for these kids it can be sorely missed. Open identity sperm donation is intended to address this basic human desire.

What is an Open ID Donor?

An Open Identity Donor refers to a donor who has agreed to at least one form of contact with any donation-born offspring once the child turns 18.

ESB-USA was the first U.S. sperm bank to specialize in providing this option to donor conceived children. Our entire catalog consists of donors listed as such. In America, this is the fastest growing trend among sperm banks due to the transparency and comfort it provides.

What does this mean for your child?

When a donor child reaches 18 years old, he or she may request contact with the donor through our bank. Contact must be initiated by the child. Customer identities are confidential and are never released to sperm donors. If your child wishes to establish communication with his/her donor, we will make the connection and arrange a mutually agreed upon method of contact. It could be a meeting, a phone call, or simply an exchange of information. It will be a communication between two adults who will be able to decide how they best want to move forward.

ESB-USA requires a means with which to contact our donors even after they retire from the program. We attain every donor's social security number in order to follow up with them in the future.

What does this mean for your donor?

All donors are required to go through a maturity evaluation by the sperm bank's managing director and donor coordinator. This is to ensure they understand the parameters and responsibilities associated with their decision of becoming an open identity donor. Once the paperwork



is submitted to ESB-USA, an Open ID donor cannot switch to become an anonymous donor. At European Sperm Bank USA, these donors have voluntarily agreed to at least one contact with the child. Sperm donors have no legal rights, responsibilities or obligations to any children born through the use of their semen. There is no requirement that the donor commit to a long-term relationship with the child, although he and the child may arrange to have further communication.

Giving your child the opportunity to choose

Choosing a Donor

While prospective parents don't get to meet their selected sperm donor, there is a lot to learn about donors through profile information.

At European Sperm Bank USA, we have found that the open identity donors are usually willing to provide more detailed content such as baby photos and extended essays to the sperm bank.

Many potential parents find security in knowing their child will be able to have some contact with their donor. However, even if an open identity





donor is selected, there is no guarantee that the donor will have the same wishes as the parent and child beyond an initial meeting. To help you select the right donor, European Sperm Bank USA offers extensive information on each participant, ranging from the results of a donor's personality test to staff impressions. Donor Screening

We use industry leading donor screening and testing procedures and we adhere strictly to FDA regulations of sperm banks as well as several international health authorities' screening guidelines. All of our donor applicants undergo an extensive screening process.

Initially our donors are selected by our sperm bank staff, based on a number of parameters:

- Cystic Fibrosis screening for 33-86 mutations in the Cystic Fibrosis gene
- Chromosome analysis
- Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) testing was implemented in the fall of 2010 and all active donors have been tested.
- Tay-Sachs disease (donors with Jewish or French Canadian ancestry)
- Canavan disease (donors with Jewish ancestry)
- Familial Dysautonomia (donors with Jewish ancestry)
- Fanconi Anemia type C (donors with Jewish ancestry)
- Gaucher disease (donors with Jewish ancestry)
- Niemann-Pick type A disease (donors with Jewish ancestry)


