Leading the Industry in Donor Screening

In addition to our Open ID donor policy, we evaluate each donor using industry-leading donor screening and extensive testing procedures, to ensure the donor sperm we offer is the highest possible quality.

We adhere strictly to FDA regulations of sperm banks as well as several international health authorities' screening guidelines.

DONOR QUALIFICATION

Initially, our donors are screened on several specific parameters:

- · Sperm Quality
- · Age
- · Education
- Criminal Background Check
- · 4-Generation Family Health History

MEDICAL TESTING

- · Physical Exam every 6 months
- · STI Testing
- · CMV
- · Urinanalysis
- · Chemistry Panel

FAMILY HISTORY REVIEW

Our certified genetic counselors complete a 4-generation family history review of all potential donors. This review aids in the identification of patterns that may signify an increased health risk to any offspring. Only donors who meet eligibility criteria are accepted into the program.



In every 1,000 of our applicants, only 10 qualify for donation.



Extended Genetic Carrier Screening & CMV

SSB was the first sperm bank to start extended genetic carrier screening in 2015. We continue to lead the way in genetic carrier screening by screening donors on up to 514 genetic conditions.

Why is genetic carrier screening important?

Carrier screening provides information about an individual's chance of having a child affected with a recessively inherited disorder. These disorders can be caused when they are inherited from both the egg and sperm. All SSB donors are screened for up to 514 genetic conditions and every report is available to you. To ensure a reduced risk to any future children, you can confirm that the egg and sperm sources are not both carriers for the same genetic condition.

Karyotype Testing

All donors complete a genetic test called karyotype to confirm they have a normal set of chromosomes. This will be reported as 46, XY indicating they have the correct number of chromosomes, 46 plus an X and Y chromosome.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT CMV



CMV stands for Cytomegalovirus. It is part of the herpes virus family which includes chicken pox, cold sores, and infectious mononucleosis.



Since we test for the presence of CMV antibodies, donors will either be negative or positive. Available donors will never have an active CMV infection at the time of donation. However, you may see CMV+ donors who have had past CMV exposure and now have the presence of CMV antibodies.



Ultimately, you need to speak with your healthcare team about donor compatibility for your needs.

Open ID Donors, a Choice for All Futures

WHAT IS AN OPEN ID DONOR?

This term means that a donor has agreed to at least one form of contact with any donor conceived child once they turn 18.

WHY ARE OPEN ID DONORS IMPORTANT?

We understand the complexity of being donor conceived. Someone may desire to know more about their donor's story from family traits to life histories. Open identity sperm donation is intended to address this basic human curiosity and a sense of belonging.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOUR CHILD?

When a donor conceived child reaches 18 years old, they may request to initiate contact with their donor through our bank. The donor conceived child must initiate the contact as parent and child identities are confidential and never released to the sperm donor.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

This is a meaningful option available for your child in the future regardless of the donor you choose. Report your birth with us to ensure your child will have access when the time is right.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOUR DONOR?

Donors are required to go through a donor counseling upon entering our program. This ensures they understand the responsibilities associated with becoming a donor at Seattle Sperm Bank.

Choosing Vials -What to Know

We offer a vareity of vials for various types of treatment, whether at your Provider's office or at home.



IUI, or washed vials, are the most common vial type and can be used for all plans.



ICI, or unwashed vials, are less common and are as effective as IUI vials, and can be used for all treatment plans.

ART and ICSI vial types are best suited for advanced IVF procedures. Speak to your healthcare team before purchasing these vial types.





IUI ART and ICI ART vials are created for advanced IVF procedures. These vials contain much fewer sperm cells that their counterparts, which would not be as effective for all treatment types as a single vial.





ICSI vials are a specialized type of vial with limited number of motile sperm cells created for advanced IVF procedures.


